



Principal – Maple Leaf International School – Horinger

Job Description & Requirements

Maple Leaf International School – Horinger invites applications from school leaders who thrive in intercultural environments to apply for the position of Principal. Horinger is the capital city of Inner Mongolia, the northernmost province of People’s Republic of China. The climate is moderately cool, ranging from an average of -12 C in January to 22 C in July with about 15” of precipitation annually. Originally a trading centre, it is now home to handcraft industries such as leather processing, rug-making, clothing production, grain milling, sugar refining, iron and steel production and a large chemical plant. It is an important agricultural centre for China. Hohhot is also the home of the first university in Inner Mongolia, with important schools of medicine and veterinary medicine.

Maple Leaf International School-Horinger, will be opened in September 2021, and will be offering the Maple Leaf World School Program to Grade 10 students in its first year, Grade 10-11 in 2022 and Grade 10-12 in 2023. The school will admit students from throughout Inner Mongolia as well as from around China who are interested in studying abroad, have a strong work ethic, and sufficient ability to study in English and to learn gaining the Maple Leaf advantages.

Maple Leaf is looking for an enthusiastic, energetic principal who will develop the World School Program at MLIS Huhhot and grow the enrolment to a thriving high school in Inner Mongolia. The starting enrolment is expected to be 25-50 Grade 10 students. The high school Program will operate together with the Maple Leaf elementary and middle school in a new facility. Students will be enrolled in one of three programs based on language proficiency as determined by the student’s results on the MLES Entrance Examination. Students will be enrolled in Foundations,

Bridging or the Full International Program, which enables students to enrol in top universities around the world upon graduation.

The successful candidate will be attracted to this unique opportunity to strengthen a positive school culture in a well-established school, and will meet the following requirements:

Required Education and Experience

- Evidence of enrollment in a Masters program, or completion of a Masters degree;
- Teacher certification from an approved Teacher Education Program in an English speaking University in Canada, USA, UK, Ireland, Australia, New Zealand or countries in Europe.
- Minimum of three complete years of successful teaching in a certified public, independent or offshore school and a minimum of two years of administrative experience (vice-principal, principal, system director)
- Enthusiastic about implementing the newly developed Maple Leaf World School Program in the inaugural year of MLIS Horinger.
- Familiarity with the technology used in supporting student learning and experience with differentiated teaching practices related to inclusion, diversity and teaching students with exceptionalities;
- Ability to create a strong team amongst a small group of experienced staff;
- Ability to work in an intercultural setting where building relationships with all partners that share the facilities will be critical to the success of the program and the school;
- Knowledge of the World School curriculum, instruction and assessment strategies;
- Qualifications and demonstrated ability to teach at the secondary level;
- Intercultural communication skills and a desire to live and work in China;
- A willingness to engage in student recruitment activities and activities which profile the school within the community;
- Previous experience in BC Offshore Schools is desirable but not required;
- Familiarity and experience with Student Management Software such as PowerSchool, Canvas and Office 365
